Wilder Schools 2023 - 2024

As many of you will know, last year Macaws class worked very closely with Harriet, from the Surrey Wildlife Trust.



It was the first year of a three-year project to enhance and begin to fully utilise our fantastic school grounds. They all worked incredibly hard and my goodness, the progress that they made was incredible. They raised awareness of the importance of supporting and encouraging our local wildlife, fund raised, made bird feeders, created a wildflower meadow and a bee bank, encouraged 'actions for nature' in our wider community, led school assemblies and much more.

Harriet also ran workshops with a number of other classes: taking part in the RSPB Big Garden Bird Watch, pond dipping and creating natural art. The year ended with Felbridge School winning the Wilder Schools 2024 competition (and £500 to spend on our school grounds!) with the most 'actions for nature' in the local community – a very well-deserved win. Macaws - Racing to School at Lingfield Racecourse

On Thursday, Macaws Class had a fabulous day at Lingfield Racecourse. We went behind the scenes to the weighing room and saw the horses being unloaded from the horseboxes. We learnt about how the horses are cared for, a little bit about the history of

racing and did a lot of maths! We investigated imperial and metric measurements, looked at the weight of the clothing and equipment that jockeys use, learnt about the lengths of different races and the different types of races, looked at the jumps (which were huge!), estimated and measured the perimeter of the parade ring and calculated how many horses could fit in this area, ran a race on the track, had juice and biscuits (very important!) and much more besides. The sun shone throughout and our day ended with us all watching a real life horse race. We had a great day and learnt loads!
