Well done Geckos!



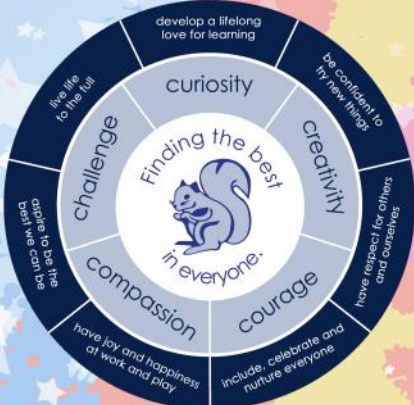
