Dear parents and carers

This week we have been immersing ourselves in reading, culminating yesterday with World Book Day, which is always one of my favourite days of the year! Overall, Felbridge came 6th out of 11 schools which was a real achievement considering we only had 6 swimmers and some were participating in back to back races.

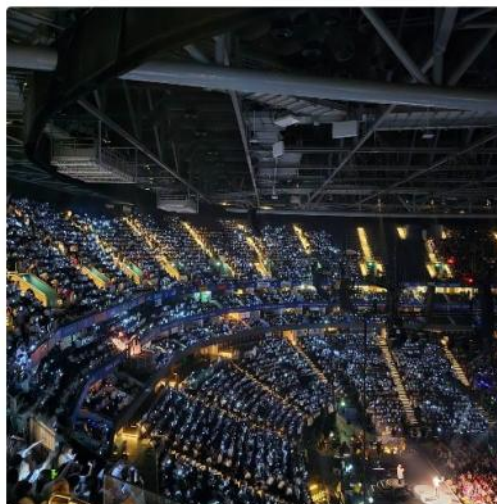
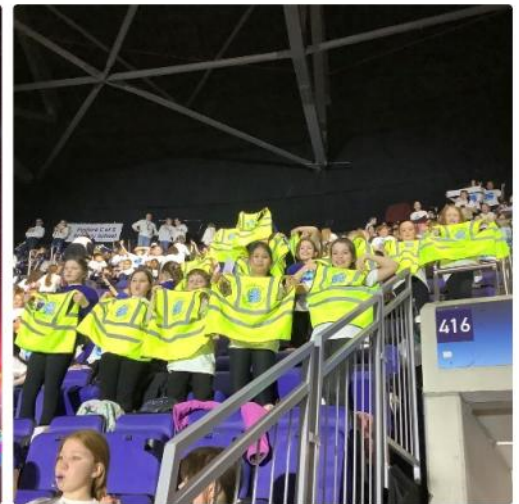
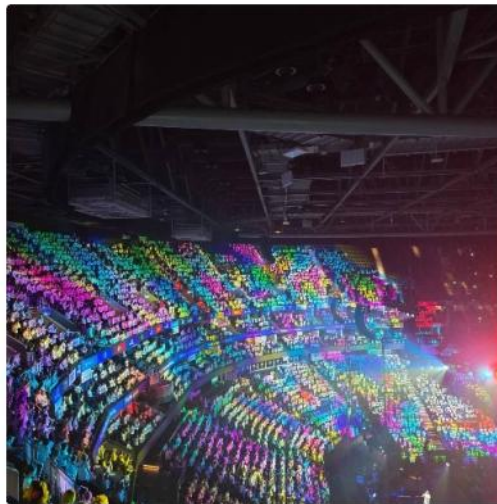
The children were brilliant, demonstrating unquestionable teamwork and resilience.

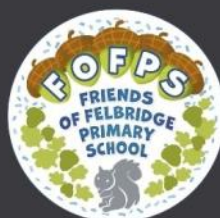

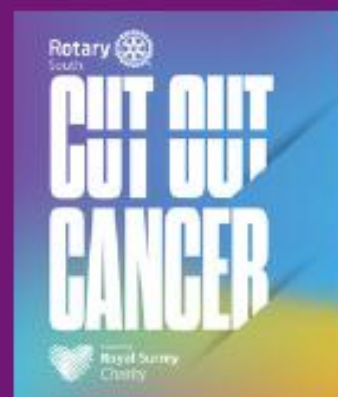

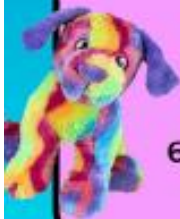
