

### Dear parents and carers

As you are aware this week has been children's mental health week. Although we are continuously aware of children's well-being and mental health, it has been lovely to be able to highlight its importance during this week.

On Monday, in assembly, I introduced the theme of 'This is my place', with a focus on belonging. We talked about what it is like to belong to something or somewhere and how it might feel if someone feels that they do not belong. The children thought of ways that we could help someone who may feel like this, such as, being kind, involving them in a game, helping or supporting them and even something as simple as a smile or a hello. The teachers have continued these discussions throughout the week.

Dr Clark led an assembly on Tuesday on the importance of staying safe online - this was linked to Safer Internet Day. All classes completed an e-safety lesson, with the opportunity to discuss this important topic and ask any questions. I hope some of you were able to attend the live e-safety webinar for parents on Tuesday evening.

Each class took part in a session in the hall, culminating in a whole school celebration at the end of the day, showcasing some of the moves, tricks and skips. It has been great to see the enthusiasm of the children transferred to break times, where skipping has really taken off!

Today we have finished the week with our 'Wear something that makes you feel happy' day, not forgetting the Reception Fairy Tale tea party. There are so many fairy tale characters in school today and what a great effort with the costumes - well done Geckos!

Throughout the week, all of the children have created a self-portrait which will form a whole school display on the theme of belonging - I will share this with you once the pictures are collated.




