What does my child need in school?

Homework & reading diaries



Weekly homework will be set on a Friday.

It should be completed by the following Friday, each week.

Maths will be either a Mathematics task or a written task.

Spellings (Friday) to be completed throughout the week and handed in the following Friday.

There will be a short punctuation and grammar task to complete each week.

Reading diaries will be collected in on a Friday. Please encourage your children to read a minimum of four times a week. Please check and sign their diaries. These need to be in school every day.

This will all help to prepare your child for secondary school.

Attendance



Statistics show that **children who have an attendance level of 95% and above are far more likely to achieve academic success than those with poor attendance who tend to fall behind in their learning.** Across the school year:

$\frac{1}{2}$ day missed every week or 1 day a fortnight = 90% attendance by the end of the year

1 day missed every week = 80% attendance

1 school year at 90% attendance = **4 whole weeks** of lessons missed.

1 school year at 80% attendance = **8 whole weeks** of lessons missed.

We know there are some children for whom absence is unavoidable. Don't send genuinely sick children to school and don't forget the very important 48-hour NHS rules for sickness and diarrhoea.
